COLLECTIVISM
We tend to hesitate in giving our opinions before knowing what others have to say or may think

SHAME

I am concerned with what others have to say about me if I do something wrong

RELATIONSHIPS
Social competencies are more valued than cognitive competencies

EQUALITY

Work and responsibilities should be given to those who are most competent, of age or seniority

COLLECTIVISM
Collaboration and a sense of group achievement and loyalty have primacy over personal goals

TASK

The basis of doing business with another person is to agree on a written contract

HIGH CONTEXT
We focus more on implicit meaning and nonverbal communication (what we say is not what we get)

INDIVIDUALISM
I need to express my opinion without needing others have to say, feel or think

MONOCHRONIC
I prefer to set and meet deadlines and to be punctual

SHAME

I rely heavily on values, philosophy and common knowledge

POLYCHRONIC
We can be flexible over deadlines and events

GUILT

I have a strong sense of absolute right and wrong

LOW CONTEXT
When giving feedback, people are expected to be direct and to the point

MONOCHRONIC
I tend to do only one thing at a time in a more efficient

RELIGIOUS SPIRITUAL
I believe the religious obligations that I set are a part of the moral code of conducting

CONTROL

I believe I have control over the environment that I have to function in

SECULAR

Professionals must be the moral voice of the workplace area of self-regulated obligations

EQUALITY

Management may choose to promote equality by the change

RELATIONSHIPS

Relationships are more important than the individual's goals

SECULAR

TASK

The task is more important than the relationship in the communication

When giving feedback, people are expected to be direct and to the point





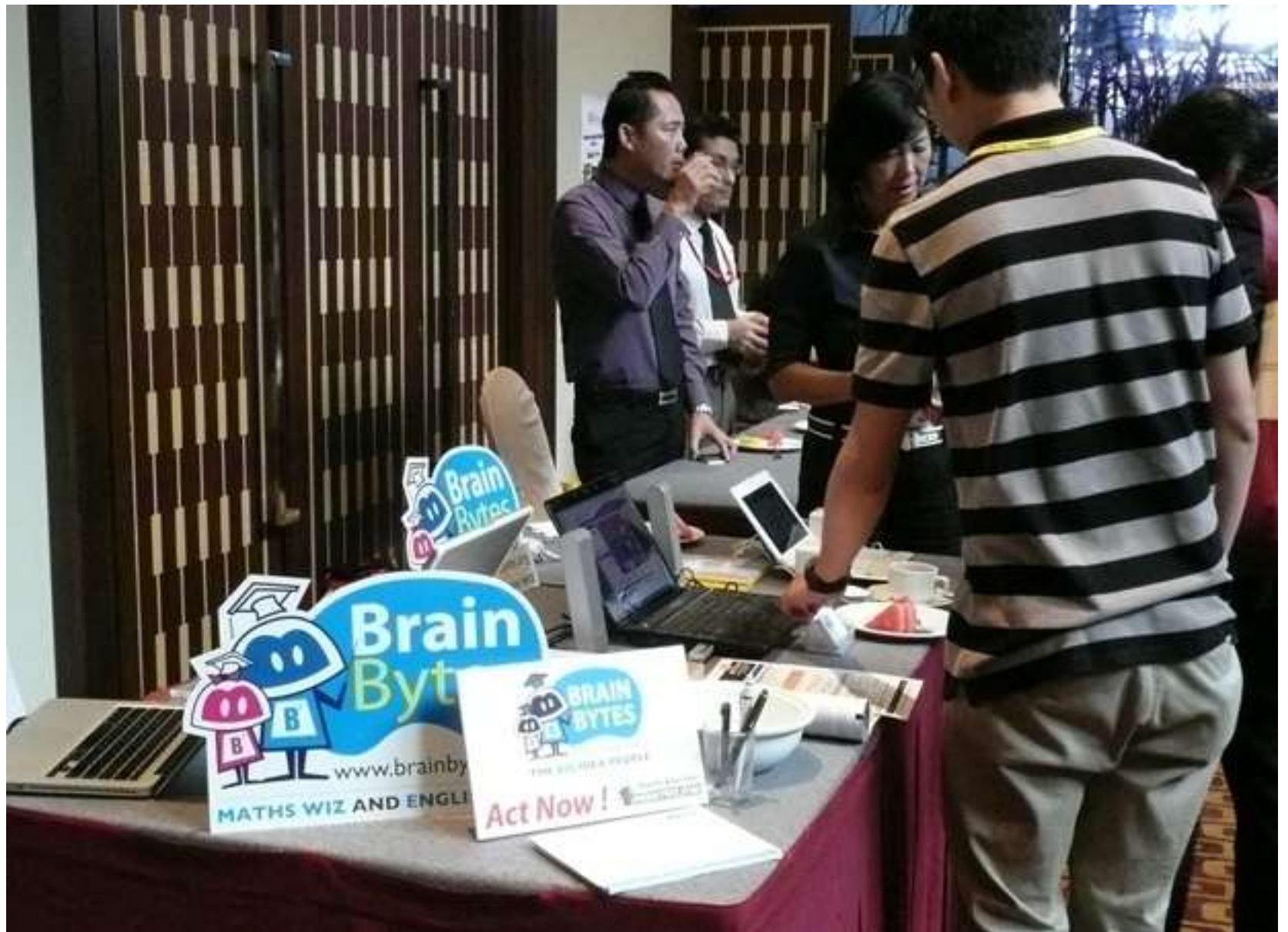
